PROGRAM LENGTH

Joint Degree: Students enter partner schools as freshmen, begin radiology classes/clinical experiences with BRCN the sophomore year, in the fall semester, and earn a degree in 4-years.

Direct Transfer: Students transfer directly into BRCN, begin radiology classes/clinical experiences, in the fall semester, and earn a degree in 3-years.

Students complete over 1300 hours of hands-on clinical experiences and are expected to travel up to 125 miles to various clinical sites.
